Register of National Demonstrators

The A.A.B.C. is trying to maintain a high quality of demonstrators, lecturers and teachers, so that all clubs can benefit from the knowledge and experience that these people have gained over many years. Their willingness to give this information to help you and your members is something that all clubs should budget for at least every two years. We feel that as the A.A.B.C., after hosting very successful Seminars over the past few years, is now in a strong financial position to help clubs carry some of the cost involved in using the Visiting Tutor Program.

All clubs that are financial members and have been for at least one year are eligible to use this facility once each year.

As we anticipate much wider use of the VTP, we need to entice more experienced bonsai people to become, demonstrators lecturers etc. As there may be some people who are good at one particular facet of teaching e.g. demonstrating but are not able to conduct workshops or vice versa etc. we have structured a two tiered system consisting of

- A. Those who can cover a full range of subjects and are proficient in conducting workshops, demonstrations, lectures, critiques etc.
- B. Those who may be proficient or choose to only cover one or two of these aspects.

We will be asking Clubs to put forward nominations for suitable persons from their Club on the correct form that will be available on the A.A.B.C website or on request from the Secretary.

It will be up to the discretion of responsible committee members from the club applying, to ensure that the highest standards are maintained, the selected demonstrator, lecturer etc. should be able to perform adequately in the chosen field and have the backing of the Clubs' Committee, the final acceptance will be up to the Executive Committee of the A.A.B.C.

LIST OF RECOMMENDED FEES

A. LEVEL ONE

Each single event should not be more than 3 hours duration.

A base fee of \$180 --\$300 for a major demonstration.

A base fee of \$120 for a smaller club demonstration or lecture.

Workshops at a minimum \$20 per person, with a minimum 6 participants and maximum of 10. If less than 6 participants a minimum fee of \$120 would be applicable. Observers at workshops \$5 per head with these proceeds usually going to the host club to help defray costs.

Extra costs incurred i.e. taxi fares or shuttle bus to and from airport, accommodation and meals should be paid by the host club with prior arrangement with the demonstrator.

Critiques are usually conducted free of charge.

Cost and supply of demonstration materials should be negotiated with the Artist prior to the event.

B. LEVEL TWO

Each single event should be not more than 3 hours duration (depending on experience, 2 hours may be adequate).

A base fee of \$150 -- \$300 for a major demonstration.

A base fee of \$80 for a smaller club demonstration or lecture.

Workshops and extra costs as per level one.

The above costs are only a guideline and are negotiable with the Artist.

When Nomination Forms are received and accepted the information about each demonstrator will be entered on the form below. These forms will comprise the Register of National Demonstrators.


The Register will be entered on the web site.
