Representatives on the AABC Committee:

Incorporated Societies/Clubs

Each Member Club that is an Incorporated Body is eligible to nominate **two** of its members to be its **Representatives** on the Committee of the Association.

Societies/Clubs not Incorporated

Member Clubs that are not Incorporated cannot be a member in their own right but can nominate a **Designated Officer** of the Club to be the representative member of the Association rather than the Club itself.

General Meetings:

The Association generally only has two meetings each year. A General Meeting is held during the convention in May and the Annual General Meeting is usually held in September. It is not essential that Committee Members attend the meetings and Member Clubs can nominate proxies. If any other decisions are required during the year they are conducted by email or mail.

Insurance:

The AABC has an insurance policy and welcomes all Member Clubs to actively participate in the provision of a reasonable and low cost insurance policy. The policy covers all shows or displays conducted by Member Clubs that participate providing that they are official Club activities.
